Cook

Job Description

- Produce In-Kind as needed.
- Order food and supplies based on menus.
- Keep inventory up to date.
- Complete all required paperwork.
- Working as a team member to ensure all regulations are met during food preparation and service.

Qualifications

- Will obtain food handler certificate.
- Experience in commercial or school kitchen service preferred.
- Food manager or food handler certification preferred.

Bus Driver

Job Description

- To safely transport children to and from Head Start Centers, and on approved Head Start activities or functions.
- You will establish/update bus routes.
- You must complete and maintain all required paperwork along with completing daily safety and maintenance checks of your bus.
- You will conduct evacuation drills.
- You must follow all rules, regulations and responsibilities set forth by Kentucky Department of Transportation and Performance Standards.

Qualifications

- Must have Commercial Drivers License (CDL) with PS endorsement.
- Good driving record with no convictions concerning vehicle operation in the past 12 months.
- Must be twenty-one years of age.

Bus Monitor

Job Description

- Helping children on and off the bus.
- Helping the children buckle seat belts.
- Support the driver in maintaining bus rules.
- Implement age and developmentally appropriate activities with the children during the bus ride and keeping required paperwork up to date and accurate.

Qualifications

• Must have transportation to meet the driver.

All positions require a valid Kentucky driver's license, and a high school diploma or GED. Applicant must be able to pass preemployment and random drug testing throughout employment. All applicants must be able to pass a Criminal Record Check and a Child Abuse and Neglect Check. Also all applicants must have a current physical examination and TB skin test upon hire.
